Maton Rye is a widely adapted, excellent tillering variety. **Maton** combines superior early forage production and increased total forage yield. **Maton** offers increased grain yields and improved disease tolerance particularly to leaf rust, septoria leaf blotch and anthracnose. It appears to be better adapted to southern Oklahoma and other southern states.

MANAGEMENT

PLANTING RATES: Drill – 60 - 120 lbs./acre
Broadcast – 120 - 150 lbs./acre
SEEDLING DEPTH: ¼" to ½"
PLANTING TIME: Plains – Aug - Sept; Deep South – Sept - Oct
West TX – Sept - Feb
pH: Tolerates a pH of 5.5 - 7.5
FERTILIZER: 200 - 300 lbs./acre
