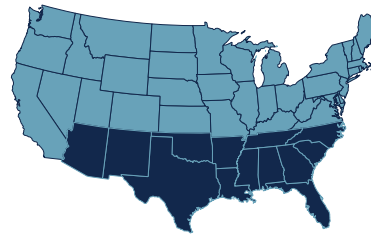

MANAGEMENT

SOIL TEMP:	Plant at 60° F soil temperature	Cut for hay approximately 45-60 days or at first boot stage
SEEDING DEPTH:	1" to 1½"	Great for cattle, goats and sheep
PLANTING RATES:	Dryland – 15-40 lbs. Irrigated – 30-60 lbs.
